Development Report: Melanie Bargar: Student lottery was today, of the 181 applications, 110 were accepted for 9<sup>th</sup> grade, 25 applications for 10, 11, and 12<sup>th</sup> grades. Bill Roach and I are February keynote speakers for Pleasantburg and Greer Rotary meetings. Community service opportunity April 9<sup>th</sup> at the City Hall Health Fair, and May 7<sup>th</sup> there is a Charity Bike Race. Our Pledge letter campaign has had a 70% response with 200 parents pledging time or money. The GMC Annual Spring Fling will be Saturday May 14<sup>th</sup>, from 3 to 5 PM on the GTC campus. April 16<sup>th</sup>, from 9 AM to 2 PM is the Drive For Your School at George Coleman Ford.

Facilities Report: Keith Jones: Fire alarms are going into the Administrative, Rest room, and Science buildings. Administrative building has had office walls added and the plumbing has been started. Currently working out problems with parking and the GTC campus to extend our parking areas. Land lease ends in June, hope to extend the property line to allow us to gravel an additional area for parking.

Finance Report: Skip Snow: Budgeting shortfalls due to assumption of 300 student enrollment while actual enrollment was 284, and change in student weighting figures. Revenue is still on target.
