Dear Parents,

I hope you all had a wonderful summer and are ready for a great 2017-2018 school year. I wanted you to be aware of what the procedures are for this semester on **FRIDAYS** for your child's college and/or college seminar class period.

Students taking college classes have the opportunity to not attend school during their college class **AND** college seminar class period. However, they must be on campus for their high school classes and Blazer Block (advisory). A student may not come to school, leave, and come back. If their college class is in the middle of the day they should report to the college seminar room. This is a unique privilege for students taking college courses. Failure to comply with the guidelines will result in the privilege being taken away.

Students should use this time to complete service hours, study at home, or serve in their work places and/or community. We hope that they will use this time wisely. If a student falls below a 70 in their college classes this privilege will be taken away until they pull up their grades. You will be notified immediately if this is the case.
