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Facts and Highlights of 2015-2016 Year

Our 2016 Graduates (98 students)

- Received over \$3.9 million in scholarship money projected over four years at 25 different colleges and/or universities.
- 97% went on to further their education by enrolling in a college or university.
- 86.7% of GMC seniors took a total of 669 college courses during their four years. They earned 2391 college credit hours with a 99.2% pass rate.
- 95.9% of our seniors graduated with at least a 3.0 GPA.

Our Student Body

- Twenty GMC students have received Associate Degrees from Greenville Tech since 2012 and four have earned double associate degrees.
- GMC students surpassed Greenville County's and the state's average passing rate on End of Course exams.
- GMC students scored higher than the state and national averages on the PSAT and ACT and the state average on SAT.
- Over 20,000 community service hours served each year
